## **2. CONFLICT OF COMMITMENT TOOLKIT – APM 671**

To support compliance with Conflict of Commitment and Conflict of Interest in Research reporting requirements the Office of Academic Personnel in partnership with the Office of Research Compliance developed a toolkit of training material and resources. ### **Academic Personnel Manual (APM) 671:**

APM 671 is UC's policy on conflict of commitment and outside activities, and the disposition of income earned from OPAs. The policy provides guidance for the identification and management of OPAs, in order to avoid conflicts of commitment, while assuring that Health Sciences Compensation Plan (the "Compensation Plan") participants may engage in a wide array of outside activities without unnecessary limitations.
