

Statistics of the Unsheltered

- 552,830 individuals experience homelessness on any given night throughout the United States
- 151,278 individuals experience homelessness in California
- 5,570 individuals experience homelessness in Sacramento

About Joshua's House

- Named in honor of Joshua Lee, who died unsheltered on the streets of Omaha, Nebraska at the age of 34 years old
- Future home for the terminally ill unsheltered in Sacramento
- Provides hospice services via community partnerships and end-of-life Doulas


Project Purpose

Volunteer End-of-Life Doula Policy
















- Researched similar roles in other
